
PROGRAM: Public Art Program

DEPARTMENT: Parks, Recreation and Community Resources

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Based on the work of the Arlington Arts Commission and County staff, the County Board adopted a Public Art Policy in September 2000. The purpose of the policy is to provide appropriate guidelines, staff, and other project resources necessary to allow for the inclusion of public art in both private development and on public land. The funding amount for this program is based on an amount up to ½% of the total cost of CIP projects in the following program categories: Local Parks and Recreation, Transportation and Pedestrian Initiatives; Community Conservation; Public Safety Facilities; and Government Facilities.

PLANNING RELATIONSHIP: As a result of County Board funding in FY 2002 and FY 2003, staff has been hired to begin implementation of the Public Art Policy. Currently, staff is developing a Public Art Master Plan that will be used to program available funding.
