
PROGRAM: Bridge Rehabilitation

DEPARTMENT: Public Works

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: This is an ongoing program which provides funds to continue the rehabilitation of 30 County-maintained bridges in order to assure an adequate level of safety for pedestrian and vehicle traffic.

PLANNING RELATIONSHIP: Federal law mandates that bridges be inspected and maintained according to Federal and State codes and guidelines. Projects in this program are identified as a result of biennial inspections of vehicular and pedestrian bridges. The next biennial inspections are scheduled for FY 2004. Generally, rehabilitation is scheduled for the fiscal year following the biennial inspections.
