
PROGRAM: Neighborhood Traffic Calming

DEPARTMENT: Public Works

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: The purpose of the Neighborhood Traffic Calming (NTC) program is to implement the NTC policy to provide transition from commercial areas to residential neighborhoods by lessening the impact on those neighborhoods by addressing concerns of high speed and traffic volume.

PLANNING RELATIONSHIP: The County's adopted Master Transportation Plan identifies neighborhood streets and generally indicates which measures are available to influence the speed and volume of traffic using the street. In FY 2000, the Board adopted the NTC process, criteria, and measures. The NTC program provides specific procedures and criteria for the implementation of traffic calming measures on neighborhood streets. Project selection is determined by a formal process conducted jointly with a citizen committee and county staff to direct resources to streets where travel speeds and traffic volumes meet adopted criteria.
