PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Northern Virginia Regional Identification System (NOVARIS) is a computer system that facilitates the identification of fingerprints found at a crime scene. The computer and operational offices are physically located at the Massey Building, 4100 Chain Bridge Road, in Fairfax. Personnel assigned to the site by all participating jurisdictions staff the NOVARIS center. The use of the system and the corresponding costs are prorated based on population. Arlington County's share is 11.4 percent.
