
PROGRAM: Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Academy

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: This appropriation will fund the County's share of the acquisition and development cost for the Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Academy (NVCJA) facility. This funding request represents Arlington's capital share lease payment for its portion of the 15-year financing. The acquisition was undertaken because the Academy could no longer rent the former Claremont School from the Arlington School Board. The new Academy site is located at the intersection of Routes 7 and 28 in eastern Loudoun County. The primary participant jurisdictions and regional authorities include Arlington, Alexandria, Loudoun, Fairfax City, and the Washington Metropolitan Area Airports Authority.
